ORDER

This case is before the Court for consideration of the RECEIVER’S FINAL REPORT AND MOTION TO (A) APPROVE ACCOUNTING; (B) ESTABLISH RESERVE & MAKE A FINAL DISTRIBUTION; (C) ABANDON REMAINING RECORDS & ASSETS; AND (D) DISCHARGE AND RELEASE THE RECEIVER [].


After review of the Report, Motion, and related exhibit, and noting that no objections have been filed, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pat Huddleston, II, the duly authorized and acting Receiver (the “Receiver”) is authorized:

- (a) To establish a reserve and to distribute it at his discretion;
- (b) To abandon the records and assets in accordance with the Receiver's Final Report and Motion; and
- (c) To file a report with this Court certifying that the Final Distribution has been made.
- (d) Upon the Receiver's distribution of the reserve and the Receiver's filing of the report set forth in paragraph (c), this receivership shall be terminated and closed without the necessity of further Order of the Court and: (i) Pat Huddleston, II, shall be fully relieved and discharged of all of his duties and obligations under the Order appointing him as Receiver, and any other duties or obligations incident to his service or appointment as Receiver in this case, and (ii) Pat Huddleston, II and his attorneys, and accountants (the "Receiver's Team") shall be fully released and discharged from any and all claims and causes of action which might be brought against them for matters arising from their administration of the assets turned over to the Receiver.
- (e) Neither the Receiver nor any member of the Receiver's Team shall have any liability, to any person or entity, for any action taken in good

faith in connection with carrying out the procedures set forth in this Order or in carrying any other duties or obligations incident to this receivership.

- (f) This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters relating to this receivership and the Receiver Estate.
